

## **Practice Fields**

- You can sign up in August -

Fields are scheduled from after school until dusk in the Fall and, with some exceptions, after school until 6:00 in the Spring.

If you have moveable goals on the field, do not practice with them in the goal mouth. It creates unnecessary wear and tear on the fields. Move them around.

With some exceptions, your practice field will remain the same between the Fall and Spring unless you are requested to change. Changes are accommodated based on availability.

Field conditions and availability change from year to year due to maintenance and sports programming throughout the city so the following field information may not be totally up to date. Field are scheduled on a first come, first serve basis.

- I. Gore (east Cambridge) M-F 3:30-6
  - a. (2) 6x6 teams
  - b. Monday thru Friday Fall only
  - c. East Cambridge
  - d. Advantages – grass cover and parking
  - e. Disadvantages – relocation for Spring Season
  
- II. Ahern (east Cambridge) Tues, Thurs & Friday 4:30-6
  - a. (3) 6x6 teams
  - b. Advantages – grass cover and parking
  - c. Disadvantages – practice must end at 5:45 in the Spring
  
- III. Sennott (mid Cambridge) Tues, Thurs & Friday 4:30-6
  - a. (2) 6x6 teams
  - b. Availability – Tuesday, Thursday, Friday in Fall. Monday thru Friday in Spring.
  - c. Advantages – grass cover, parking, Central Cambridge  
Disadvantages – caution must be taken about balls in the street
  
- IV. Pacific Street (Cambridgeport) M-F 3:30-6
  - a. (2-3) 6x6 teams
  - b. Advantages – parking, Cambridgeport location, exclusively CYS field
  - c. Disadvantages – if three teams are scheduled, they need to rotate on to the primary field
  - d. Available after 6:00 on in Spring
  
- V. Cambridge Common (Harvard Square) M-F 3:30-6
  - a. (2) 6x6 or 11x11 teams
  - b. Advantages – one set of 11x11 pipe goals, MBTA accessible, centralized location.
  - c. Disadvantages – grass cover, parking and potential for balls to go onto street.

- VI. Sacramento (between Harvard & Porter Square) M-F 3:30-6
  - a. (1) 6x6 team
  - b. Advantages – grass cover, centralized location
  - c. Disadvantages – parking
  
- VII. Raymond (west Cambridge) M-F 3:30-6
  - a. (2) 6x6 teams
  - b. Advantages – grass cover, parking
  - c. Disadvantages – must be off at 5:45 in the Spring
  
- VIII. Glacken (Fresh Pond) Tues, Thurs & Friday 3:30-6
  - a. (2) 11x11 teams
  - b. Tuesday, Thursday, Friday in the Fall and Monday through Friday in the Spring.
  - c. Advantages – grass cover, parking
  - d. Disadvantages – none
  
- IX. Danehy - Field 6 (Fresh Pond) M-F 3:30-6
  - a. (2) 6x6 teams
  - b. Advantages – grass cover
  - c. Disadvantages – drainage, accessibility and field closure when Danehy is closed
  
- X. Danehy - Field 2 (Fresh Pond) M-F 3:30-6
  - a. (2) 11x11 teams
  - b. Advantages – grass cover, parking
  - c. Disadvantages – field closure by Danehy
  
- XI. Russell (Alewife) Tues – Friday 3:30-6
  - a. Tuesday through Friday in Fall
  - b. Monday through Friday in Spring
  - c. (2) 11x11 teams in Fall
  - d. (4) 11x11 teams in Spring
  - e. Advantages – grass cover, parking, MBTA accessible
  - f. Disadvantages – competition with football in the Fall, practice cancellation for team placements in spring
  
- XII. Hoyt (Riverside) M-F 5-6:30
  - a. (2-3) 6x6 teams
  - b. Advantages – Riverside, Cambridgeport area, grass cover, parking
  - c. Disadvantages – not available in the Spring
  
- XIII. Tobin M-F 3:30-6
  - a. (1) 6x6 team
  - b. Advantages – parking, grass cover
  - c. Disadvantages – gets crowded in Spring with baseball
